That is why the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) has undertaken the Regional Goods Movement Study. This study involves the comprehensive evaluation of the movement of freight from trucks, railroads, ships and pipelines. The study will be used to develop a plan for a safe and efficient goods movement system that will enhance freight mobility and economic competitiveness, while mitigating the community impacts of goods movement.

For this study, four evening public meetings will be conducted and we need your participation! These meetings will include a panel of private sector freight stakeholders and community leaders. The panelists will address community concerns and insight into the local freight operations, and there will be an appearance by America's Road Team and the "Share the Road" Program sponsored by the American Trucking Association.
